Native Stingless Bees have a new home at St Paul's Garden

- They are a perfect pet for schools because they don't sting!
- The hive is in the big tree near the St Paul Potters Garden
- They only come out of their hive if it's 18°C or warmer.
- They fly and forage for food within a 500 metre radius from the hive.
- Sydney Stingless Bees are native to Sydney.
- They are roughly 4mm long. We need bees because bees pollinate the plants that we use to grow food. We simply can't live without bees. By hosting a beehive we are adding to the bee population and to our own wellbeing.



STAR SPOT

On the 17 & 18 November, Noah S competed in State Relays at Homebush. This was a team event and Noah competed as part of a Jumps Team and part of a Throws Team. 


