Child Protection Requirements for Volunteers

It is most important that all Volunteers complete the volunteers training on the Catholic Education Department of Parramatta (CEDP) website. This is a requirement of the CEDP.

'Building Child Safe Communities' has been developed by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta and enhances our commitment to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all students in our care. It is now a requirement that all volunteers complete an online 'Undertaking Form' that confirms expectations in relation to behaviour whilst volunteering at schools, Catholic Out of School Hours Care and Catholic Early Learning Centres. This undertaking form also seeks to determine the suitability of volunteers and contractors by requiring them to declare they do not have a criminal history involving children.

Step 1 – Building Safe Communities Undertaking for Volunteers; Step 2 – Online Training Module.

Please ensure both these modules are complete before volunteering. You will receive a confirmation email once the form has been submitted and the school will receive notification that you have completed the online training. Specific details are maintained confidentially in a central database and a copy of your confirmation is emailed to the location where you are volunteering. A new form is required for each location that you are a volunteer or if any of the details you have provided on the form change.

Volunteers – please click on 'Building Child Safe Communities – Undertaking for Volunteers' or access the form via the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta public webpage www.parra.catholic.edu.au, then click on 'Child Protection Training Forms; (half way down the page on the right hand side). You will find the online training for volunteers in the same area.

We look forward to working with you as volunteers and thank you for your support of Catholic Education.

Kiss 'n' Drop

Please take extra care at Kiss 'n' Drop in the mornings. Children are to exit the car on the passenger side, with their bags and walk straight into school using the gate near the office. Children using Kiss 'n' Drop are NOT to enter the school using the gate that leads directly to the playground. We also ask that parents do not get out of the car as this slows down the process. If you are concerned that Kiss 'n' Drop is not the best option, please know that you are always welcome to park and walk your children in.

10 km/h SPEED LIMIT

School Attendance - Leave from school within School Terms

Families are encouraged to holiday or travel during official school holidays. A Leave period of between one and four (4) school days will require a notification to the class teacher prior to the planned leave. If the leave is for more than 5 school days parents are asked to complete an Application of Extended Leave Form A.1 which can be obtained from the school office. Once the leave is approved a certificate of permission will be sent home for you to take with you on your travels as proof that the leave from school has been authorized.

Student Absence from School

If your child has been unwell and absent from school it is **essential** that a letter explaining the absence be forwarded to your child's teacher when your child returns to school. The school now has the Skoolbag App which can be downloaded to your phone and used to notify us of an absence. The Class Roll is a legal document and as such it is the school's responsibility to monitor student attendance. It is very important that the information in the Class Roll is accurate as this information is **reportable to the Department of Education**.

As you can imagine it is very important that we follow the above procedures and we do appreciate your cooperation.

eLIBRARY

All school libraries across the Catholic Diocese of Parramatta allow students and parents to access the school's online library catalogue, databases and ebooks from school or home. Students can download and enjoy many digital learning tools and resources available through eLibrary including books, ebooks, audiobooks, databases and videos.

Students can access eLibrary through classm8.parra.catholic.edu.au and enter their username and password, this will direct them to their individual school e-library.
